All 6 spiritual senses, though marvelous as they are, are insufficient for us to enter into His Rest.

In truth, we have been given these six senses to ex-perience temptation and disappointment. And when we, through our senses, are about to lose all ex-spect-ation of Him, we die. When we are thus dying we come to realize that with these 6 senses He has actually fed us on the substance of Faith (the uniting of flesh and spirit), but inside of us This will finally lead us to 'seeing' Him in our enemy, our 'self', and... at the very end of our 6th day. Then we enter into His Rest, to become the revelation of Him in our 7th day.
